

## Manufactured Home Service

- Manufactured homes have to be in place or marked how the home is going to be placed. *(The property must be staked out so our engineer knows exactly how much work is involved and what costs may apply).*
- REA Energy needs to set all meter pole services for trailers. Only poles set by REA Energy are acceptable for metering and service equipment, the pole is owned and maintained by REA. *(Ask for the current price).*
- Electric service equipment must be inspected by a licensed PA Electrical Inspector. *(Once we receive paperwork letting us know that everything has passed inspection, we will then set a meter).*

## Signing up For Service

**When coming to the office for a new service, remember to bring the following items:**

- Valid photo ID
- Last four digits of your Social Security Number
- Copy of the deed *(if you own the property)*
- \$5 for a Membership Fee
- \$100 for a Security Deposit and Property Owner's name *(if renting)*
- \$110 Meter Set fee *(if applicable)*
- \$20.00 service hook up/transfer fee will be applied to the first electric bill

## Also, have the answers to the following questions:

- Who has REA electric service closest to where you are building?
- What type of heating will you use?
- Will you have central air conditioning?
- Are you interested in receiving a free electric hot water tank? *(Some conditions may apply).*
- Is this a new service for a permanent structure or manufactured home?

- Is the structure staked out or started? *(Prior to a REA Energy field assessment, the property must be staked out so our engineer knows exactly how much work is involved and what costs may apply).*

- Will you need temporary service?
